*Letter*

Before leaving for Paris I wish to let you know that your portrait will be glazed and packed by Mr. Remy, from whom the frame was procured, and it will be delivered to your London address next Saturday, the 23rd.

I much regret that I shall be unable to include it in my Paris Exhibition, as it was still too wet to be packed with the other pictures which had to be dispatched ten days ago, and it is only to-day that it could be varnished, but I hope you will be good enough to let me have it for my next London Exhibition.

I leave to-morrow, and my address in Paris will be Hotel Majestic, Avenue Kleber, where I shall be until June 10th.

After the portrait was varnished I had it photographed by Mr. Paul Laib, who does all my pictures, and he will send you a proof.
